Taste Initially spicy orange peel, a "dark" flavor, lightly tingling spearmint, all embraced by old-fashioned vanilla drops. Behind it all, subdued but distinct oak

Finish Age and oak become more intense, orange oil lingers, discreet leather notes emerge
