Despite the high strength, the flavor remains intense yet balanced—with high ester content, rich aroma, and a bold character that commands attention. A powerful but refined experience—meant to be enjoyed in good company and quiet moments.

### TASTING NOTES

<b>Aroma</b>	Stewed dark fruit, burnt figs, orange peel and a small, well-integrated ‘bite’ from the otherwise high alcohol content
<b>Taste</b>	Creamy, spicy and very full-bodied with sherry caramel, dates, cardamom and eucalyptus
<b>Finish</b>	Long and creamy and spiced with a delightful mint overtone
<b>Color</b>	Mahogany
