A SUN-RIPENED ORANGE LIQUEUR WITH ROOTS IN THE HISTORY OF ST. CROIX

Old St. Croix Orange Grove is inspired by the historic area of Orange Grove on the island of St. Croix, where orange orchards once thrived alongside fields of sugarcane under the Caribbean sun. Orange Grove is a tribute to the island's gentle climate and its abundant fruits, whose aroma and natural sweetness give this liqueur its warm, tropical orange character.

The liqueur continues the West Indian traditions of flavor and craftsmanship. The aromas of sun-ripened oranges blend with fresh citrus notes and warm spices in a harmonious composition that balances sweetness, freshness, and depth. Maturation in oak casks adds further complexity with subtle layers of vanilla, toasted wood, and brown sugar.

Orange Grove can be enjoyed neat, on the rocks – or as a sweet and aromatic ingredient in classic cocktails made with orange liqueur, such as the Margarita, Cosmopolitan, or Mai Tai.

TASTING NOTES

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| <i>Aroma</i> | Dried orange and apricot followed by a light and fresh note of spearmint |
| <i>Taste</i> | Spicy fruit candy with deep, concentrated notes of orange and mandarin. Followed by nuances of lightly toasted brown sugar. Finished with a touch of toasted wood |
| <i>Finish</i> | Spearmint with a hint of dried orange and a harmonious rounding of tropical fruits |
| <i>Color</i> | Light gold |



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
